Hose down your pet thoroughly so that their panting slows down & to prevent their temperature from rising further



Ring your Vet to tell them you're on your way Immediate Veterinary attention is required.

DON'T take a 'wait & see' approach



In the car, keep the air conditioning on, or the windows fully down to keep your pet cool



At the Vet, Treatment may include IV fluids, oxygen, or blood tests to see if organ damage has occurred.



Severe cases have a significant risk of death & may require hospitalisation for up to 10 days.
