

**1** Hose down your pet thoroughly so that their panting slows down & to prevent their temperature from rising further



**2** Ring your Vet to tell them you're on your way. Immediate Veterinary attention is required. DON'T take a 'wait & see' approach



**3** In the car, keep the air conditioning on, or the windows fully down to keep your pet cool



**4** At the Vet, Treatment may include IV fluids, oxygen, or blood tests to see if organ damage has occurred.



**5** Severe cases have a significant risk of death & may require hospitalisation for up to 10 days.
